### Dear Colleagues and Friends,

The summer is almost over for most of us, although some people feel that the most pleasant part of it is late August-beginning of September.

This summer has not been particularly pleasant. We have had a lot of natural and human-made disasters in Europe: catastrophic wildfires, floods, earthquakes...Our natural surrounding is gradually being destroyed. Is this due to climate change? Is it due to human indifference? Is it due to human malevolence? Is it due to the punishment of humanity by the super-God Zeus sent to us by thunder from Olympus mountain?

WARS are continuing! It is indeed surprising that, in spite of the development of the neo-cortex in humans and the miraculous achievements of humanity, yet we are unable to resolve conflicts peacefully and continue behaving in primitive ways based on aggression and power rather than empathy and justice.


